

Step Up for Patients Campaign Coalition Toolkit

During the lame-duck session of Congress, members of the Safe Step Coalition will be launching a comprehensive outreach campaign to pressure Congress to include the Safe Step Act in one of the legislative packages that will be voted on before the end of the year.

This toolkit provides resources you can use to promote this campaign to your email list and across your social media channels. Each item is customizable to highlight your organization's mission and focus area.

The exact launch date of this campaign will depend on how quickly Congress gets to work following the election. This timing could be impacted by the election results and/or any delays in naming the winner of the presidential election.

Emails: General Recommendations

Subject line: Can be 45-60 characters in length. An iPhone will only show 32 characters. Desktops will show longer subject lines. The tone and style should be based on the performance of your previous email sends.

Pre-header: Optimal length is up to 100 characters while shorter pre-headers will show more completely on a mobile device.

Personalization: Include first name personalization at the beginning of the email as if you were writing a letter to a friend.

Signature: Emails should be sent from an individual – with an actual name – from your organization. They should not come from “The Advocacy Team” or the organization’s name.

Testing: Before sending your email, be sure to send test versions and view them on a desktop and mobile device. Ideally, you’ll send test messages to the most prevalent email providers, including Gmail, Yahoo and Outlook.

Email #1 to Volunteers – Step Up Social Media Activity

FirstName,

This is the best chance we've ever had!

And we have to act quickly.

We've learned that Congress is strongly considering voting on our bill that helps [disease] patients get more immediate access to the treatment their doctor recommends rather than first being forced to suffer through their health insurance company's preferred (cheaper) prescription.

We are launching a new campaign to make clear to Congress that patients have waited long enough – it's time to pass this bill.

I need your help and I promise that it's easy to do:

1. Take a picture of yourself standing on a step. Any step will do.
2. Use our sample pre-written social media post (you can edit it) and post your picture to social media.

Your steps can be anywhere - at home, in your office, inside or outside. The location doesn't matter. What does matter is getting your picture posted so we can pressure Congress to pass this important legislation.

We've been working for two years to pass this bill. If we don't get it done now then we will have to start all over next year.

Email #2 to Volunteers – Call Senator Schumer

FirstName,

This is very important.

One of our top priority bills - which would help tens of thousands of [disease] patients - is being needlessly held up in the U.S. Senate.

Today, we're joining with dozens of other health organizations to pressure Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer to pass this vital legislation now. If we don't pass the bill this month, we could have to wait two more years for an opportunity – delays that our patients can't afford.

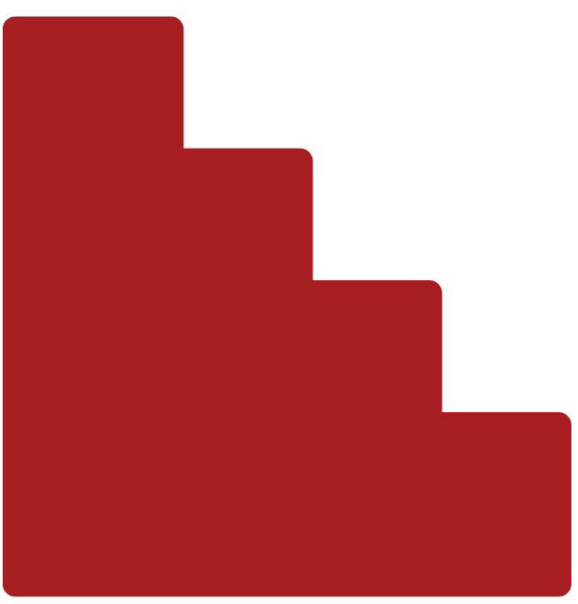

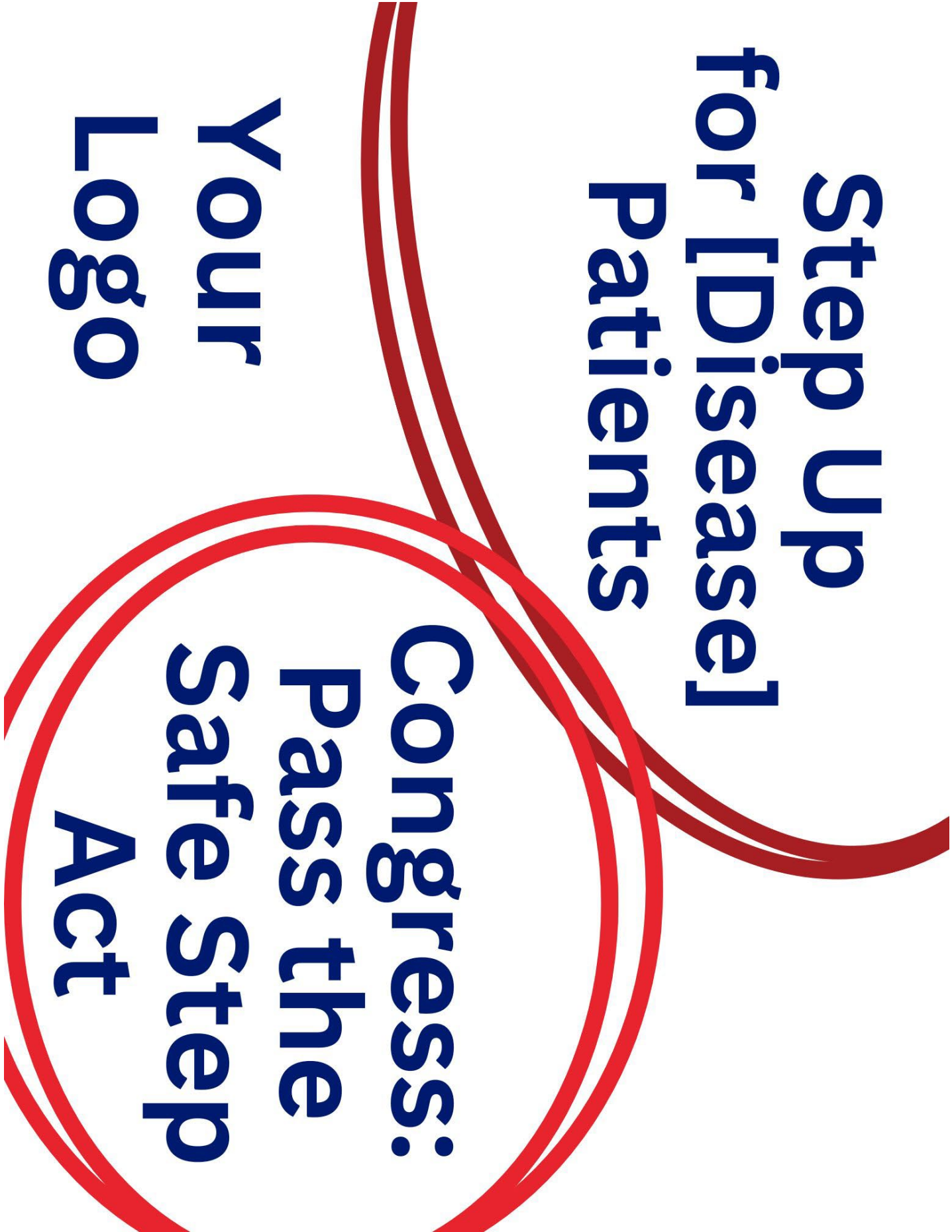
